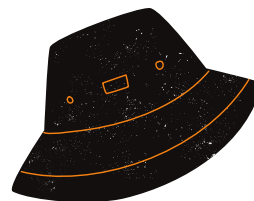

Our School pool opens from Tuesday, 26th October.

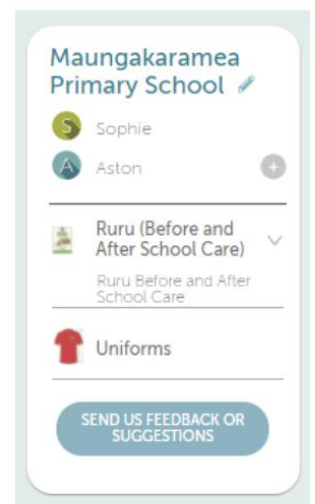
