COUNTRY DAY

FRIDAY, 21 OCTOBER

Country Day is coming soon on Friday, 21st October (end of week one). Everyone is welcome, so come and share the day with us.

We will be holding a cake auction (but there is no competition as there has been in previous years). The silent auction will run from 9am to 2pm - please bring your cakes before 9am.

Lambs and goats arrive between 8.30 and 9.00am for registration. Judging will be held in the morning, with prizegiving around 11am. This prizegiving will also include the indoor exhibits. Small pets and decorated calves register at 11.30, with judging for small pets and decorated animals following registration, and prizegiving at the end of this section.

Non-decorated calves register from 12.30pm, with judging starting from 1pm. Prizegiving is expected to be around 2pm, with the cake auction results at the start of this prizegiving.

Indoor exhibit judging will be held after school on Thursday, 20th October, so please no parents in classrooms at this time.

Refreshments will be available, so bring some cash.











EFTPOS

Just a reminder that we are retiring our EFTPOS machine at the end of Term 3. From Term 4, all transactions will be via cash or Kindo. If you would like assistance with your Kindo account, please contact the office.

POOL KEYS

Pool keys will be available for purchase in Term 4. Numbers are strictly limited, and keys will be issued on a first come, first served basis. The cost will be \$100 for the season, with \$30 of this being a bond refundable upon return of the key before the end of Term 1 2023.

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JUNIOR/YOUTH REGISTRATIONS

Hi all. All of NZ cricket has switched to a new online registration platform. Whanau will need to follow these links to register your child - https://www.playhg.com/new-zealandcricket/register/cd7ea0 - Supersmash Fun (C-grade Hub), SuperSmash Play (B grade) and SuperSmash (A grade) OR https://www.playhq.com/new-zealand-cricket/register/06e92e - Div 1 and Collegiate.

You may need to set up a parent portal registration. The platform should direct you to do this. Take care when selecting your child's grade. C-Grade is the 'Hub', A and B grades are 'Junior', Div and Collegiate grades are 'Youth'.

If you were previously registered with CricHQ, and would like your child's game stats transferred to PlayHQ, you'll need to log in to CricHQ. In CricHQ, find your child's CricHQ profile. At the top of their profile page, in the URL bar, is a 7-digit number. Copy this number. This is your child's player number. Once back in the PlayHQ registration form it will ask you to enter your child's player number to allow their stats to transfer from CricHQ to PlayHQ. The photo below shows you the correct number to enter.

I will email whanau who have previously registered with MGK cricket and share these details. Similarly, I will distribute a newsletter to local schools to share this information, and more, about the upcoming season.

Please get registrations in asap so we can finalise teams. NCA require us to register the teams by October 14th, so we need fair indication of player numbers before this date.
