**Tenā koutou i ngā āhuatanga o te wā,
Greetings to you all at this time**

The term and year is rumbling by and I am hearing a lot of people say “I can’t believe it’s June”.

Mid Year Reporting to parents/Interviews:

–On-going reporting: Class teachers and students have been placing excellent information about what children are doing in class and the progress children are making through Seesaw. Please go on and check it out. This is an on-going style of reporting to parents and has been happening throughout the year.

–Mid Year Snapshot (Report): These will be handed to students to bring home on 20th June. Please read these prior to Interviews.

–Parent/Teacher Interviews: These interviews are focused more around academic achievement.

Date: Wednesday and Thursday Week 9 Term 2 (21st and 22nd June)

Time: 10 minute Interviews from 1.30– 6pm

School Closed: School will finish at 1pm both of these days.

Ruru: Ruru will be available on both of these days. There is a \$5 charge for students not booked in for the afternoon Ruru session, starting at 3pm. If you have booked your child in for afterschool care starting at 3pm, there will be no additional charge for 1–3pm.

How to book: Jena will be sending out a survey for booking Interviews. Keep an eye out for this.

–Performance in Key Assessment (PiKA): Students in Year 4–8 will have a data assessment sheet begin handed and discussed out at interviews. These are progress only and will help with setting goals and looking at areas where support or extension is needed. In some cases these will not be shared, but teachers will discuss this with you if this is the case.

These assessment sheets should be read in conjunction with our Mid Year Snapshot, as together they will give you an overall indication of how your child is progressing.

Winter Illness:

Please keep a close eye on your children as we have a lot of illness at present and keep them home if they are not well enough to be at school. Don’t forget to give your child a RAT test if they are symptomatic to rule out COVID.
